US 41 Project lane closures for June 6 – June 10

Traffic restrictions in Winnebago & Brown counties

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region in Green Bay is announcing US 41 lane restrictions for June 6 through June 10 in the communities of Oshkosh and De Pere. Drivers in Winnebago County are reminded of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits on US 41 between WIS 26 and Breezewood Lane. Traffic impacts in Brown County involve lane closures at Scheuring Road in De Pere.

Winnebago County

WIS 26 – WIS 21

Tuesday, June 7 and Wednesday, June 8:

- Right lane of northbound US 41, between County Z and WIS 26, closed Tuesday and Wednesday from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. for shoulder work.

US 45 – Breezewood Lane

Monday, June 6:

- Various lane closures on southbound WIS 76, between Green Valley Road and the northbound US 41 off-ramp to WIS 76, on Monday from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Motorists can also expect lane restrictions on the southbound US 41 off-ramp to WIS 76 during this time. Closures are needed for work on the US 41 bridges over WIS 76.

Tuesday, June 7:

- Various lane closures on north and southbound US 41, between US 45 and WIS 114, Tuesday from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. These lane restrictions are needed to maintain pavement markings.

Brown County

Scheuring Road

Monday, June 6 – Thursday, June 9:

- Various lane closures on north and southbound US 41 at Scheuring Road from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday through Thursday nights, for construction of the new Scheuring Road interchange.

All lane restrictions are weather dependent and subject to change.
