US 41 Project lane closures for June 13 – June 17

Traffic restrictions in Brown and Winnebago counties

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region in Green Bay is announcing US 41 lane restrictions for June 13 through June 17 in Brown and Winnebago counties. Traffic impacts in Brown County involve lane closures at Scheuring Road in De Pere and on WIS 29 just west of Green Bay. Access between WIS 29 and County J closes permanently on Monday, June 13, when construction begins on the County J underpass project at WIS 29. Drivers in Winnebago County are reminded of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits on US 41 between WIS 26 and Breezewood Lane.

Winnebago County

WIS 21 – US 45

Wednesday, June 15:

- Various lanes of southbound US 41, between Snell Road and Lake Butte des Morts, closed Wednesday from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. for pavement maintenance.

US 45 – Breezewood Lane

Wednesday, June 15 and Thursday, June 16:

- Right lane of northbound US 41, between County G and Breezewood Lane, closed overnight Wednesday and Thursday from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. The closures are needed for setting retaining wall panels.

Brown County

Scheuring Road

Monday, June 13 – Thursday, June 16:

- Various lane closures on north and southbound US 41 at Scheuring Road from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday through Thursday nights, for construction of the new Scheuring Road interchange.

WIS 29

Monday, June 13 – Thursday, June 16:

- Various lane closures on east and westbound WIS 29, between Packerland Drive and County FF, Monday through Thursday nights from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., for work in the median.

Monday, June 13:

- Construction on County J underpass at WIS 29 begins Monday, June 13. Access between County J and WIS 29 will close permanently. Motorists need to seek alternate routes.

All lane restrictions are weather dependent and subject to change.
