US 41 Project lane closures March 7 – March 11

Traffic restrictions affecting US 41 in Winnebago & Brown counties

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region Office in Green Bay is announcing US 41 lane restrictions for March 7 through March 11 in the areas of Oshkosh and De Pere. In Oshkosh, all traffic will be shifted to newly expanded southbound lanes between WIS 26 and Witzel Avenue. Traffic impacts in Brown County involve lanes closures at Scheuring Road.

Winnebago County

WIS 26 - WIS 21

Monday, March 7 – Friday, March 11:

- Tuesday, March 8, all US 41 traffic between WIS 26 and Witzel Avenue will be shifted to recently expanded southbound lanes (two lanes in each direction) to allow reconstruction and expansion of northbound lanes. Motorists should expect 11-foot travel lanes and 55 mph speed limit.
- Various lanes of US 41 northbound and southbound, between WIS 26 and County Z, closed Monday through Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. The lane closures are required to install a Dynamic Message Sign.
- Various lanes of US 41 northbound and southbound, between WIS 21 and County Z, closed Monday through Thursday from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. to prepare for expansion of northbound lanes.

Brown County

Scheuring Road

Monday, March 7 – Friday, March 11:

- Left lane of US 41 northbound at Scheuring Road, closed Monday through Thursday from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. These lane closures needed for the reconstruction of the Scheuring Road overpass.

All lane restrictions are weather dependant and subject to change. Motorists should use extreme caution and remain alert when driving through any work zone.

ABOUT THE US 41 PROJECT

WisDOT is initiating expansion and improvement of 31 miles of US 41 in Brown and Winnebago Counties. The project will include road expansion to accommodate increased traffic volume, up to 44 new roundabouts, improved interchanges and expansion of the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway.
