Traffic impacts on US 41 at WIS 76 and Lake Butte des Morts Causeway *Winnebago County closures for the week of May 24*

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region Office in Green Bay is announcing lane restrictions for the week of May 24 on US 41 in Oshkosh. Motorists can expect closures in northbound lanes near the WIS 76 interchange and in northbound and southbound lanes over the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway. All lane restrictions will take place during overnight hours.

Monday, May 24 through Wednesday, May 26:

- Right lane of US 41 northbound near the WIS 76 interchange closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for the reconstruction of the ramps connecting US 41 to WIS 76. Speed limits in the area reduced to 55 miles per hour

Tuesday, May 25:

- Left lane of US 41 northbound and southbound between US 45 and WIS 21 closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to allow construction of the future Lake Butte des Morts Drive overpass

Wednesday, May 26:

- Right lane of US 41 southbound between US 45 and WIS 21 closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for bridge maintenance

All closures are weather dependant and subject to change. Motorists are reminded to use caution and remain alert when driving through this or any work zone.
