**Lane closures on US 41 at Lake Butte des Morts and north of Snell Road**  
*Winnebago County traffic impacts for the week of July 18*

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region Office in Green Bay is announcing lane restrictions for the week of July 18 on US 41 in the Oshkosh area. Motorists can expect closures in northbound lanes between Snell Road and Breezewood Lane, on the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway and in southbound lanes near Breezewood Lane interchange. All closures take place during overnight hours.

Sunday, July 18 through Friday, July 23:

- Various lanes of US 41 northbound between Snell Road and Breezewood Lane closed Sunday through Thursday from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., and Friday from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. The project involves widening the existing northbound lanes. Speed limits in the area reduced to 55 miles per hour.

Monday, July 19 through Tuesday, July 20:

- Various lanes of US 41 southbound from the Breezewood Lane interchange south to where US 41 crosses the railroad spur line just north of County Road G, closed from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Monday, July 19 and Wednesday, July 21:

- On July 19, right lane of US 41 northbound between WIS 21 and US 45 closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. and on July 21, various lanes of US 41 northbound in same area closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. During work on July 21, the US 41 northbound on ramp from WIS 21 closed to traffic.

All closures are weather dependant and subject to change. Motorists should use caution and remain alert when driving in this or any work zone.
