Inspections scheduled for bridges in Green Bay, Menasha and Oshkosh

Next week's work includes cleaning, testing and maintenance

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Regional office in Green Bay is announcing work taking place next week on various bridges in the cities of Green Bay in Brown County and Menasha and Oshkosh in Winnebago County. This work includes maintenance, testing, cleaning, and inspections. It is weather dependant and times could vary, depending on how quickly the work is completed.

This is the tentative schedule:

- Monday, April 11, 2011
 - Racine Street (Menasha) – Bridge will be **closed** from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Tuesday, April 12
 - Mason Street (Green Bay) – Bridge will be **closed** from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
 - Oregon Street/Jackson Street (Oshkosh) – Lane closures on bridge from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
 - Main Street (Oshkosh) – There will be multiple openings on the bridge for testing from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Wednesday, April 13
 - Mason Street Bridge (Green Bay) – Lane closures on the bridge from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
 - Oregon Street/Jackson Street (Oshkosh) – Lane closures on bridge from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
 - Racine Street (Oshkosh) – Lane closures on bridge from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
 - Main Street (Oshkosh) – There will be multiple openings on the bridge for testing from approximately 8 a.m. to noon
 - Congress Street (Oshkosh) - There will be multiple openings on the bridge for testing from approximately 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Thursday, April 14
 - Walnut Street (Green Bay) – Bridge will be **closed** from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
 - Oregon Street/Jackson Street (Oshkosh) – Lane closures on bridge from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
 - Tayco Street (Menasha) – Lane closures on bridge from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Friday, April 15
 - Tayco Street (Menasha) - Lane closures on bridge from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Motorists should seek new routes, anticipate backups, remain alert and use caution when driving through these or any work zones.
