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Northeast Wisconsin road construction projects for 2012

Tentative schedule for WisDOT projects

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) NE Regional Office in Green Bay is providing a tentative listing of construction projects scheduled in the region for 2012. The list includes state projects on interstates, the United States highway system, and the Wisconsin state highway system. Construction costs for these projects are estimated at approximately \$ 339 million.

Be advised that schedules are subject to change. Where project costs are not listed, the projects have not been let to bid. Once construction has begun on a project, updates on traffic impacts and construction progress will be available on WisDOT's weekly construction media release, distributed every Friday, tentatively set to begin in late February.

The Northeast Region includes the counties of Brown, Calumet, Door, Fond du Lac, Kewaunee, Manitowoc, Marinette, Oconto, Outagamie, Sheboygan, and Winnebago.

Motorists are advised to use caution and remain alert when driving through any work zone.

Drivers are also encouraged to seek information about work zones and detours at the following locations:

Region Wide Deck Sealing

Location: Fond du Lac, Outagamie, Winnebago Counties

Schedule: To be determined

Length of project: N/A

Description of work: Deck sealing and traffic control.

Traffic impacts: Short term lane closures on various highways. Night work is allowed.

I-43

Location: Leo Frigo Bridge, Irwin Avenue-Atkinson Drive

Schedule: June to December

Length of project: 2 miles

Description of work: The work consists of deck repairs, joint replacements, and an overlay of the Leo Frigo Bridge; deck repairs and overlays of the Atkinson Drive Bridge and Military Ave. Bridge over I-43; pavement and joint repairs on I-43 from Irwin Ave. to Military Ave.; and intersection improvements on both the I-43 southbound entrance ramp at Atkinson Drive and northbound exit ramp at Webster Avenue.

Traffic impacts: I-43 northbound and southbound will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction for the majority of the project between the project limits. During the lane closures on I-43, the Atkinson Drive southbound entrance ramp to I-43 will be closed, and the Webster Avenue northbound entrance ramp to I-43 will be closed. From the middle of August to the middle of October the Webster Avenue southbound exit ramp will be closed to I-43. For the deck repairs and overlays on Atkinson Drive Bridge traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction. For the deck repairs and overlays of the Military Ave. Bridge the bridge will be closed, but will not be closed concurrently with the Atkinson Drive bridge repairs. Please note: Motorists should expect delays and plan alternative routes.

WIS 96

Location: WIS 96, village of Wrightstown, Fox River Bridge and Approaches - Raze and Removal Contract

Schedule: August 2012 to September 2013

Length of project: 0.4 miles

Description of work: Removal of buildings and site clearance prior to utility relocations at the proposed bridge and approaches. Work will be determined by the schedule of closings on properties.

Traffic impacts: Removals may require flagging operations or shoulder closures of a short duration during hauling operations.

US 141

Location: Velp Avenue, City of Green Bay, Norwood Ave to Military Ave

Schedule: April to November

Length of project: 1.6 miles

Description of work: Roadway reconstruction and construction of roundabout at Military Ave.

Traffic impacts: Road will be open to one lane of traffic in each direction.

WIS 54

Location: Duck Creek Bridge Replacement and Seminary Road Intersection

Schedule: April to November

Length of project: 1.0 miles

Description of work: Construction of new bridge north of existing alignment, construction of new road to the bridge, and construction of a roundabout at Seminary Road.

Traffic impacts: Traffic will be open to one-lane in each direction but side road closures will occur at various periods.

I -43

Location: Mason Street Interchange

Schedule: June to August

Length of project: All ramps and between ramps

Description of work: Widening of southeast and northwest ramps, pavement repair and overlay of all ramps, pavement repair of Mason Street between the ramps.

Traffic impacts: Off-peak lane closures will be allowed. Ramp closures will be allowed at night and over weekends.

US 41

Location: County B Interchange

Schedule: Late spring/early summer

Length of project: Southwest on-ramp

Description of work: Southwest on-ramp will be converted to a parallel entrance ramp and an anti-skid coating will be applied to the bridge over the Suamico River.

Traffic impacts: Southwest on-ramp will be closed and off-peak US 41 lane closures will occur.

WIS 96

Location: WIS 96, Wrightstown to Greenleaf

Schedule: Late summer to early fall

Length of project: 2.1 miles

Description of work: Asphalt pavement resurfacing, frost heave corrections and culver work.

Traffic impacts: Asphalt pavement resurfacing will be conducted under traffic using flaggers. Frost heave corrections and culvert work will be completed under a two week long detour. The detour route will follow County D to County Z to WIS 32/57..

Calumet County

Telulah Avenue over WIS 441, Appleton

Location: Telulah Avenue bridge over WIS 441

Schedule: July to September

Length of project: 0.1 mile

Description of work: Replacement of the existing asphalt pavement approaches to the overpass with concrete pavement and replacement of the curb and gutter, sidewalk and railing in the area where the roadway has settled at the approach to the bridge.

Traffic impacts: Telulah Avenue will be closed to traffic for the duration of the project. A detour will be signed using Telulah Avenue south to Midway Road east to Plank Road (County AP) continuing on to Lake Park Road (County LP) north to Calumet Street (County KK) west to Telulah Avenue.

US 10

Location: County HR to east corporate limits (Brillion)

Schedule: April to November

Length of project: 2 miles

Description of work: Brillion urban reconstruct involving: milling, asphalt paving, concrete removals, storm sewer replacement, curb and gutter replacement, sidewalk replacement, pavement markings

Traffic impacts: US 10 through traffic will be detoured. Detour route going east is US 10 to WIS 57 to County K to County W to US 10. Local traffic and business access will be maintained.

WIS 114

Location: WIS 114 and WIS 55 intersection

Schedule: July through the end of September

Length of project: N/A

Description of work: Reconstruct the intersection to a roundabout involving: removals, milling, new asphalt paving, new curb and gutter, new storm sewer, new pavement markings.

Traffic impacts: All WIS 114 traffic will be detoured. No local access allowed. Detour route going east is WIS 114 to US 10 to WIS 57 to WIS 114.

Fond du Lac County

WIS 67

Location: Birchwood Drive to County G

Schedule: July to mid October

Length of project: 0.3 miles

Description of work: Concrete box culvert replacement, concrete barrier, retaining walls, beam guard, asphalt pavement

Traffic impacts: WIS 67 will be closed to traffic. The detour route will follow US 45 and County F.

WIS 175

Location: County B (east) to Lost Arrow Road

Schedule: July to mid October

Length of project: 0.2 miles

Description of work: Two concrete box culvert replacements, beam guard, asphalt pavement

Traffic impacts: WIS 175 will be closed to traffic. The detour route will follow County Road B, US 41, and US 151.

Manitowoc County

US 151

Location: County A to Jackson St

Schedule: April to July

Length of project: 2.8 miles

Description of work: Valders urban construction involving: milling, asphalt paving, concrete replacement, storm sewer replacement, railroad crossing replacement

Traffic impacts: US 151 through traffic is detoured. Detour route going east is US 151 to County W to County JJ to County S. Local traffic and business access is allowed.

I-43

Location: I 43 and US 151 interchange

Schedule: June to July

Length of project: N/A

Description of work: Ramp widening involving: earthwork, concrete placement, signal replacements

Traffic impacts: US 151 traffic is reduced to one lane each way. Ramps are open with intermittent night closures. No impacts to I-43 traffic.

Marinette County

US 41

Location: Oconto to Peshtigo, city of Peshtigo

Schedule: Spring 2012 to fall 2012

Length: 2.1 miles

Description: Asphalt pavement resurfacing, miscellaneous curb and gutter replacement and bridge replacement.

Traffic Impacts: Traffic will be detoured during bridge construction on US 41 around the city of Peshtigo, from County Highway Y to Schacht Road.

US 141

Location: Amberg to Beecher/County K to County Z

Schedule: Spring 2012 to fall 2012

Length: 6.5 miles

Description: Asphalt pavement resurfacing, culvert replacement, construction of passing lanes.

Traffic Impacts: All work will be done under traffic using flagmen and signing.

Oconto County

WIS 22

Location: Gillett to Oconto Falls/W. Corporate Limits to Highland Road

Schedule: Spring 2012 to fall 2012

Length: 8.2 miles

Description: Asphalt pavement resurfacing, pulverize and relay existing pavement, common excavation and borrow, and box culvert replacements.

Traffic Impact: WIS 22 will be closed to through traffic during construction. WIS 22 traffic will be detoured via US 141, County E, and County C.

Outagamie County

WIS 15

Location: Intersection of WIS 15 and County CB in the town of Greenville

Schedule: April to September

Length of project: 0.39 mile

Description of work: Highway safety improvement project which will reconstruct the intersection of County CB with WIS 15 to a multi-lane roundabout to improve safety and operations at the intersection. A fourth leg will be constructed to the north to provide access to WIS 15 from a new town road (Neubert Road) which will provide access for

local development. Outagamie County (as a separate county project) will also be reconstructing the intersection of County CB and County GV with a roundabout at the same time.

Traffic impacts: WIS 15 will be closed to through traffic for the duration of the project. A detour for WIS 15 will be signed using US 41 south to WIS 96 west to WIS 76 north to WIS 15. The intersection of County CB at WIS 15 will be closed for the duration of the project.

WIS 55

Location: Intersection of WIS 55 and County CE in the city of Kaukauna

Schedule: June to October

Length of project: 0.16 mile

Description of work: Highway safety improvement project which will reconstruct the intersection of County CE with WIS 55 in the city of Kaukauna to a multi-lane roundabout to improve safety and operations at the intersection.

Traffic impacts: The roundabout will be built in stages maintaining through traffic on WIS 55. Sections of County CE will be closed to traffic during various stages of the project. A detour for County CE will be signed using County N south to County KK east to County GG north to County CE.

WIS 96 (Draper Street, city of Kaukauna)

Location: Draper Street in the city of Kaukauna from the west city limits with the village of Little Chute to Lawe Street (WIS 55)

Schedule: April to November

Length of project: 0.90 mile

Description of work: Complete reconstruction of Draper Street from the city limits with the village of Little Chute to Lawe Street (WIS 55).

Traffic impacts: Draper Street will be closed to traffic for the duration of the project. A detour will be signed using County N north to County OO east to WIS 55 south to WIS 96.

WIS 125 (College Avenue, town of Grand Chute and city of Appleton)

Location: College Avenue from the US 41 interchange to Linwood Drive

Schedule: April/May

Length of project: 1.50 miles

Description of work: Completion of pavement repairs that were started in the fall 2011.

Traffic impacts: Lane closures during off peak hours.

WIS 441

Location: WIS 441 northbound exit to County CE

Schedule: September to October

Length of project: 0.07 mile

Description of work: Highway safety improvement project which will reconstruct the northbound right-turn lane onto County CE to a free flow right-turn lane.

Traffic impacts: Northbound right turn lane onto County CE will be closed during the construction. Other lane closures during off peak travel hours will be necessary in order to facilitate the construction.

US 41 – Grand Chute

Location: Capitol Drive Overpass

Schedule: Approximately 2 month's worth of work beginning anytime between mid-April and early August, and ending no later than mid-October.

Length of project: N/A

Description of work: Complete removal of the existing paint and repainting of the structural steel on the Capitol Drive bridge over US 41.

Traffic impacts: US 41 may be reduced to one lane in each direction during night-time operations only. Capitol Drive will be closed to traffic. In addition to be open during the day time, all lanes of US 41 will also remain open to traffic during peak traffic times of weekends, holidays, and Packer games.

Sheboygan County

I-43

Location: South county line to WIS 42

Schedule: Late February or early March to late August 2012. .

Length of project: 18.7 miles

Description of work: Project began in fall 2010. The WIS 32 bridge deck over I-43 will be reconstructed, and the southbound I-43 bridges over County O and County J will be entirely reconstructed. The temporary I-43 median cross-over's used to stage traffic for the I-43 bridge reconstruction over County O and County J will be removed.

Traffic impacts: During the construction of the WIS 32 bridge over I-43, I-43 northbound traffic trying to access WIS 32 will be rerouted using I-43 to County AA to WIS 32. The WIS 32 bridge work is expected last approximately 2 months. The WIS 32 ramps will be closed for approximately three consecutive nights while the pavement is resurfaced. During the construction of the I-43 southbound bridges over County O and County J, both northbound and southbound I-43 traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction on the existing northbound roadway (counter-directional traffic), and the I-43 southbound on ramp at WIS 42 and off ramp at WIS 23 will be closed. I-43 southbound traffic trying to access WIS 23 during this time will be rerouted to WIS 42 to WIS 23. WIS 42 traffic trying to access I-43 southbound during this time will be rerouted to WIS 23 to I-43. Except where allowed along at the I-43 bridge reconstruction, I 43 lane closures will be prohibited during peak traffic times of weekends, holidays, and Packer games.

I-43

Location: Town of Mosel Event Interchange at Rowe Road

Schedule: July to September

Length of project: N/A

Description of work: This project will construct the second half of this event interchange, the northbound off ramp. The project will also resurface Rowe Road between the northbound off ramp and southbound on ramp termini. These ramps will be restricted to use for major golf events at Whistling Straits.

Traffic impacts: Northbound I-43 may be reduced to one lane of traffic for approximately one week. Rowe Road may be closed to through traffic for approximately one week. All lanes of I-43 will remain open to traffic during peak traffic times of weekends, holidays, and Packer games.

WIS 57

Location: South County Line to WIS 32

Schedule: Early July to early November

Length of project: 25 miles

Description of work: Replacing culvert pipes, reconstructing the WIS 57 northbound bridge over the Onion River, surface repair on the WIS 57 bridge over Otter Creek, replacing pavement on approaches to the WIS 57 bridge over the Sheboygan River, adding slotted left turn bays and new signals to the County C intersection.

Traffic impacts: WIS 57 will be closed during construction and detoured in two separate stages. The first detour will be installed for the northern construction stage (north of WIS 23), and will redirect traffic to use WIS 57, WIS 23, WIS 32 and WIS 57. This first stage of construction is expected to begin in early July and end in mid-August. The second detour will be installed for the southern construction stage (south of WIS 23), and will redirect traffic to use I-43 to WIS 23 to WIS 57. This second stage of construction is expected to begin in late August and end in early November. Local access will be maintained throughout construction.

WIS 23

Location: Sheboygan River bridge

Schedule: Two weeks, beginning summer or fall.

Length of project: N/A

Description of work: Replacement of wingwalls on the WIS 23 eastbound bridge over the Sheboygan River.

Traffic impacts: Traffic may be reduced to one lane in the eastbound direction during off-peak traffic times. All lanes of WIS 23 will remain open to traffic during peak traffic times of weekends and holidays.

Winnebago County

US 45 frontage roads

Schedule: June 2011 to September 2012

Length: 5 miles

Cost: \$13.2 million

Location: US 45; County G to County II, Winnebago County

Description: The project involves constructing frontage roads along both sides of US 45 and constructing bridges for the three local roads between County G and County II (Woodland/Breezewood, Lakeview/Oakridge, Grandview) to overpass US 45. Direct access to US 45 for these three local roads will be removed as part of the project.

Traffic impacts: Access to US 45 from Woodland/Breezewood and Grandview Roads has been eliminated. Lane closures along US 45 will take place as necessary to complete work adjacent to US 45.

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
