Meeting to discuss construction plans for US 41 overpasses at County Y, GG and G in Winnebago County

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region in Green Bay is holding a meeting to discuss construction plans for the US 41 overpasses at County Y, GG and G in Winnebago County, as part of the US 41 Project. The meeting is Wednesday, July 20 from 4 to 7 p.m. at the Winnebago County Highway Department, 901 West County Road Y, Oshkosh. The meeting is being held as an open house so the public can attend at their convenience. A short presentation begins at 4:15 p.m.

The project involves replacing the County Y and County GG overpass bridges and replacing the existing deck on the County G overpass. The overpasses will have two 12-foot driving lanes, 8-foot shoulders, and a 10-foot path for pedestrian, bicycle and snowmobile access across US 41.

The County Y overpass project involves reconstructing a portion of County Y east and west of US 41 and a portion of Green Valley Road through its intersection with County Y. The shared use path on each side of US 41 will be extended and completed in the future by Winnebago County.

Work on the County GG overpass involves reconstructing a portion of County GG east and west of US 41, a portion of Green Valley Road through its intersections with County GG and Woodenshoe Road and a portion of Old Dixie Road through its intersection with County GG.

Work on the County G and County GG overpasses is scheduled for 2015. Replacement of the County Y overpass is scheduled for 2015 based on current funding allocations. Construction could begin sooner if funding becomes available.

The public is encouraged to attend, provide input and ask questions about the project. Construction displays and schedule information will be available.
