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Full-lane closures on US 41 in Oshkosh week of March 29

Crews begin setting bridge girders for 20th Avenue overpass

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is announcing that segments of US 41 between 9th Avenue and WIS 44 in Oshkosh are scheduled to close for three nights beginning March 29, as crews place girders for the future 20th Avenue overpass. For safety reasons, this work requires full-lane closures between the hours of 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. and motorists are strongly encouraged to begin planning alternate routes.

The schedule for closures on US 41 between 9th Avenue and WIS 44 include:

Monday, March 29

- US 41 southbound lanes closed with through freeway traffic detoured to Koeller Street
- US 41 northbound passing (left) lane closed

Tuesday, March 30

- US 41 northbound and southbound lanes closed with through freeway traffic detoured to Koeller Street

Wednesday, March 31

- US 41 northbound lanes closed with through freeway traffic detoured to Koeller Street
- US 41 southbound passing (left) lanes closed

Law enforcement will monitor traffic on the detour route and portable message signs will be placed prior to construction to inform motorists. The 20th Avenue overpass is being replaced as part of the US 41 Project in Winnebago County and is valued at approximately \$2.2 million.
