A Portion of Algoma Blvd. to Close Starting June 13th

(Oshkosh, WI.) The City of Oshkosh would like to notify residents that part of Algoma Boulevard will be closed beginning June 13th, 2011. It is anticipated the closure will last for two weeks. The closure will be from Wisconsin Ave. to just west of Osceola Ave. The road is being closed to construct sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and water main. The depth and location of the utilities make maintaining traffic unsafe and impractical.

Since Algoma Blvd. is a one-way street Algoma Blvd. will be temporarily signed for two-way traffic from Osceola Ave. to Woodland Ave. to allow access to University of Wisconsin Oshkosh facilities. Residents who live on Algoma Blvd. between Vine and Woodland Avenues would gain access via High Ave. to Woodland Ave. to Algoma Blvd.

Detour signs will have "ALGOMA BLVD." placards attached. The contractor will be working from 7:00 a.m. until dark Monday through Saturday to get utility work complete on time. A signed detour for through traffic will be provided (north on Wisconsin Ave to Irving Ave, east to Jackson St., north to Murdock Ave. and west to Algoma Blvd).
