Construction Set to Begin on Melvin Avenue Storm Water Pump Station

(Oshkosh, WI.) The city of Oshkosh would like to notify residents that construction on the Melvin Avenue storm water pump station will begin during the week of April 5th or during the week of April 12th.

The construction activities may impact parking on Hazel Street and Siewert Trail to the east of Hazel Street. Staff and parents of students at Webster Stanley Elementary School and Webster Stanley Middle School may need to find an alternative parking location once construction starts.

The contractor will access the construction site from Hazel Street, near the intersection of Melvin Avenue. This access location should result in the least disturbance to school related traffic and parking.

The city has asked the contractor to make their best efforts to minimize construction related traffic and avoid deliveries of materials between the hours of 7:15 and 8:15 a.m. and 2:45 and 3:45 p.m.

The storm water pump station is expected to be operational by August 31, 2010. The final construction activities will be completed by October 31, 2010.
