Finalists Selected for Parks Director

(Oshkosh, WI.) The city of Oshkosh has narrowed the search to four finalists for the Parks Director position. The city received 89 applications, 43 of which were from Wisconsin, for the position. All four finalists are currently Directors in other communities.

The four finalists include;

- Brett Altergott is currently the Park and Recreation Director for the Village of Germantown, WI. He has ten years of experience in the field with a Bachelor’s degree in Recreation Management and a Master’s degree in Recreation Administration.
- Kenneth Elwert is currently the Parks Director for Lapeer County, MI. He has seven years of experience in the field with a Bachelor’s degree in Parks and Recreation and a Master’s degree in Parks and Recreation.
- William Maertz is currently the Parks and Recreation Director for the city of Elk River, MN. He has 15 years of experience in the field with a Bachelor’s degree in History and a Master’s degree in Public Administration.
- Raymond Maurer is currently the Director of Parks, Recreation, and Forestry for the city of Oconomowoc, WI. He has 15 years of experience in the field with a Bachelor’s degree in Community Recreation.
