Public Hearing on the Use of Grant Funds for the Proposed James Road Detention Basin Project

(Oshkosh, WI.) The city of Oshkosh will hold a public hearing on the use of grant funds for the proposed James Road Detention Basin project on Thursday December 9, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. in room 404 of City Hall.

The purpose of the public hearing is to let the public know that the city of Oshkosh applied for and received a \$1 million Community Development Block Grant – Emergency Assistance Program (CDBG-EAP) to construct the proposed James Road Detention Basin.

This proposed project is being constructed in response to flooding that was experienced in June of 2008 that resulted in significant damage to homes, businesses, and public infrastructure.

The proposed project will directly benefit low to moderate income households residing in some neighborhoods that flooded in 2008, and numerous times in previous years. Areas that directly benefit from this project are near Sawyer Creek and are located east of USH 41.

An overview of the CDBG-EAP program and the proposed James Road Detention Basin project will be given at the December 9th meeting. Residents will also have an opportunity to provide verbal and written input regarding the proposed James Road Detention Basin.
