## **Targeted H1N1 Vaccination Clinics**

(Oshkosh, WI.) The Health Services Division of the city of Oshkosh is offering Targeted H1N1 Vaccination Clinics. A variety of appointment dates and times are available Monday through Friday. Early morning, lunch time, and evening times are offered for convenience.

These clinics are only for:

- Household members of children under 6 months
- Day care providers who care for children under 6 months
- Pregnant women
- Health care workers and emergency medical services personnel who have direct patient contact or contact with infectious material
- Children from 6 months through 4 years of age
- Persons aged 5 through 18 years who have health conditions that put them at higher risk of medical complications from influenza.

The Health Services Division is not able to vaccinate any other people beyond the outlined groups at these clinics due to a temporary shortage in the H1N1 vaccine.

Vaccination is the best protection against influenza and its complications. If you have questions concerning H1N1 or if you would like to schedule an appointment for the vaccination clinics please contact the Health Service Division at (920) 236-5030.
