Background

The Tour de Titan is a bike ride that is open to the public. The ride is organized by the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh and area bicycle groups. Tour de Titan Route

(Bike route will be temporarily blocked)

- UW Oshkosh Student and Recreation Center on Pearl Avenue at Osceola Street.
- North on Osceola Street to High Avenue.
- East on High Avenue to Division Street.
- North on Division Street to Church Avenue.
- East on Church Avenue to North Main Street.
- South on North Main Street to 6th Avenue.
- West on 6th Avenue to Oregon Street.
- South on Oregon Street to West 9th Avenue.
- West on 9th Avenue to Koeller Street.
- North on Koeller Street to Witzel Avenue.
- East on Witzel Avenue to Josslyn Street.
- North on Josslyn Avenue to sports complex.
