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Weekly construction update

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) NE Regional Office in Green Bay is providing a weekly update on region construction, which includes the counties of Brown, Calumet, Door, Fond du Lac, Kewaunee, Manitowoc, Marinette, Oconto, Outagamie, Sheboygan, and Winnebago.

Motorists are advised to use caution and remain alert when driving through any work zone.

Drivers are also encouraged to seek information about work zones and detours in the following ways:

Please note: Most projects have now been suspended for the winter or will not have traffic impacts. This will be the last weekly construction update until February 2011.

Winnebago County

US 41 – northbound mainline widening and Bell Street/Breezewood Lane interchange - US 41 major

Schedule: June 2010 to October 2011

Length: 8 miles

Cost: \$27.5 million

Location: US 41 Northbound from Snell Road to Bell Street/Breezewood Lane and Bell Street/Breezewood Lane from west of Bergstrom/Gillingham Road to east of Harrison Street.

Description: The project involves widening the existing northbound lanes of US 41 including the structures over WIS 76 and the CN railroad spur. The project also includes the complete reconstruction of the Bell Street/Breezewood Lane interchange including the structures over US 41 and the CN railroad line, several retaining walls, grading, storm sewer, pavement, signing, lighting, pavement marking, and ITS systems.

November 29 to December 3: Most contract work should be complete for the year, contract work will resume March 1, 2011. Contractors will be in to install the dynamic

message sign and the beam guard to go around it in the median of US 41, south of WIS 26, from Monday, November 29 to Thursday, December 2.

Traffic impacts: Southbound US 41 traffic has been moved back to the original middle lanes on Thursday night. Closures have been removed from WIS 21, WIS 44, Washburn, and Koeller; those areas are open to traffic. Starting Monday, November 29, Green Valley Road at Fountain Avenue and Plainview Drive at Black Wolf Avenue will have a shoulder closure. US 41 traffic will be impacted by southbound and northbound inside lane closures between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., and between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. Monday, November 29 through Thursday, December 2, south of the WIS 26/US 41 interchange for approximately 2 miles.

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
