

NORTHEAST REGIONAL RESPONSE HAZ-MAT TEAM

Haz-Mat Medications Oshkosh Fire Dept

Albuterol Sulfate – 5 Unit dose vials and 5 hand – held nebulizers (Med unit has 3 additional doses)

Atropine Sulfate – 10 multi-dose vials of 8.0 mg/20ml (Med unit has 1 additional vial)

Calcium Gluconate – 2.5% mixture, prepared by taking 4 oz of KY jelly and mixing with 40 ml of 10% Calcium Gluconate

Cyanide Antidote Kits – 2 Cyanide Antidote Kits containing: 12 ampules Amyl Nitrite Inhalant, 2 Ampules of Sodium Nitrite, and 2 Vials of Sodium Thiosulfate

Methylene Blue 1% - 2 vials of 100 mg/10ml

Morgan Lens Irrigating Contact Lens System – 12 lens (Med unit has 2 additional lens)

Pralidoxime Chloride (Protopam) – 6 vials with 1 Gm and 20 ml of sterile water. Need 2 grams for each patient.

Proparacaine Hydrochloride or Tetracaine – 2 multi-dose drop dispensers (Med unit has 1 additional drop dispenser)

Sodium Bicarbonate – 4 vials with 50 mEq/50 ml (Med unit has 2 preloaded ampules)

NOTE: *The contents of the Tox Box are intended for responder use. There is enough medication for treatment of two responders. Atropine has enough for 80 minutes of treatment at 2mg every 2 minutes.*

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
