

Medications Approved Oshkosh Fire Dept For Transport

Note: *We will only transport a patient with only two drips.*

- 1) Antibiotics (any antibiotic running during transport should have initiated at least 20 minutes prior to transport)
- 2) Benzodiazepines IVP/IN only – Including Versed, Ativan (lorazepam), and Valium
- 3) Cardizem/Diltiazem Drip
- 4) Glycoprotein – Including Integrelin (eptifibatide), Aggrastat (tirofiban), and Reopro (abciximab)
- 5) Narcotics IVP and pump- Morphine Sulfate, Demerol, Dilaudid and Fentanyl
- 6) Heparin Drip and Bolus
- 7) Nitroglycerine Drip
- 8) Amiodarone Drip
- 9) Lidocaine Drip
- 10) Bicarbonate IVP and Drip
- 11) Total Parenteral Nutrition
- 12) IV fluids of: Lactated Ringers, Normal Saline, Dextrose 5%, and Dextrose 5% and 0.45% Normal Saline

***Any requests for transport of medications not listed above need to have approval of Medical Director or Battalion Chief of EMS**
