



## **RULES FOR OUTDOOR COOKING FIRES**

Outdoor cooking fires shall be ignited and maintained for the purpose of cooking food for human consumption. Cooking shall be done in commercially made cooking appliances. These appliances shall have and be used in accordance with all manufacturers' instructions, to include the following requirements:

### **Charcoal Grills:**

1. Shall not be operated on combustible balconies, decks, or patios.  
*Exception: one and two family dwellings and/or where the building, balconies and decks are protected by an automatic sprinkler system.*
2. Shall not be operated within 10 feet of any combustible construction.
3. All cooking fires shall be extinguished following the cooking operation.
4. Disposal of ashes shall be in a non-combustible container, which shall be kept outside of any/all buildings.



### **LP Gas Grills:**

1. LP gas grills using an LP gas container greater than 1 pound shall not be operated on combustible balconies or within 10 feet of combustible construction.  
*Exception: one and two family dwellings.*
