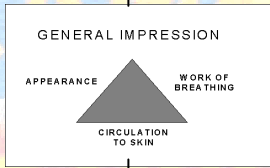


Tachycardia

Poor Profusion

Routine Medical Assessment

- Utilize the treatment triangle for assessment. Patients that present with 2 or more sides of triangle are in cardiorespiratory compromise.



Oxygen

- 100% via face mask if conscious
- 100% via BVM if unconscious

Monitor

QRS

Narrow

Wide

SVT

- Infants > 220 BPM
- Children > 180 BPM

Vagal Maneuvers

IV/IO Normal Saline

Adenosine 0.1 mg/kg (max first dose 6mg) 2 syringe technique

Adenosine (double the dose max 12 mg)

Contact Medical Control

V-Tach

Synchronized Cardioversion
1 J/kg

If no response
Synchronized
Cardioversion 2 J/Kg
