- Allen Davis, currently the Community Development Director for the Town of Grand Chute, WI. He has 26 years of experience in the field with a Bachelors degree in Economics and a Masters degree in Urban and Regional Planning.
- Brentt Michalek, currently the Director of Planning, Zoning and Construction Resources for Emmett County, MI. He has 10 years of experience in the field with a Bachelors degree in Regional Analysis and a Masters degree in Environmental Science and Policy.
- Amber Miller, currently the Planning Manager for the city of Ramsey, MN. She has 16 years of experience in the field with a Bachelors degree in Political Science, Philosophy and a Masters degree in Public Administration.

Interviews will take place at the end of January with a goal for the new Director to begin work with the city of Oshkosh in April of 2010.
