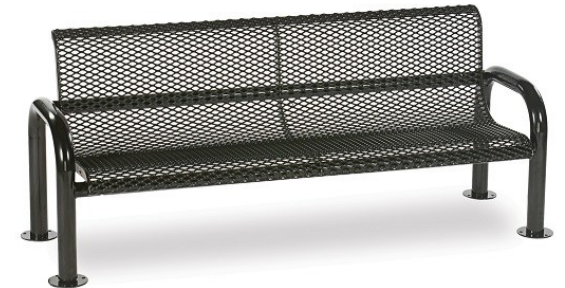

# Memorial Bench Program

The Memorial Bench Program helps you to honor a relative, friend or member of an organization and allows you to dedicate a park bench.

Through the Memorial Bench program you can provide a unique dedication to honor someone by placing a bench in one of Oshkosh’s parks, along the trails, or in the historic business district. This dedication provides a lasting remembrance while enhancing the meaning of the bench to observers. The gift is also a valuable contribution to the City to be used and enjoyed by all.



The City of Oshkosh Parks Department will be responsible for preparation, concrete and bench installation and restoration in a location mutually agreed upon between you and the Parks Department based on need and available locations. The benches are six feet long and come with an engraved metal plaque that will be attached to the bench.

The cost to donate an engraved bench is \$1,500 which includes personalization. Personalization can be created by the donor so long as it fits in a 5” x 7” space. If the donor wishes, a card of acknowledgement will be sent to the recipient’s family advising that their loved one has been memorialized or honored in this special way. A picture of the bench and a description of it’s location will be included.
