

ON THE WEEKENDS

On Saturdays, parking time limits are enforced from 9am to 6pm, the same as week days.

On Sundays and holidays (New Year's, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas), Downtown Oshkosh offers free parking in all spaces.



YOUR GUIDE TO PARKING IN DOWNTOWN OSHKOSH

The downtown parking system is designed to serve the needs of the businesses, customers, tourists, and employees. The goal of the system is to maintain a fair balance between all of these competing needs.

Please pay close attention to signage.

MONTHLY PERMIT PARKING

Permit parking spots are available to employees, employers, and residents of Downtown Oshkosh. Employers and employees are encouraged to utilize permit parking in order to leave short-term parking spaces open for their customers. The three types of parking permits are as follows:

PERMITS FOR METERED SPACES - Those with a monthly permit may use any of the parking spaces where the meter has a blue band around the post.

"ASSIGNED PERMIT" SPACES - Assigned permits come in two varieties. In most lots containing assigned permits, a specific parking stall is assigned to the user. In a few cases, the user is assigned to a group of stalls and may park in any one of them.



RESIDENTIAL - For residents living in the downtown area, monthly permits are also available. These permits reserve the parking stall for 24 hours a day.

ON-STREET PARKING

On-street parking is enforced 9am to 6pm, Monday through Saturday. No overnight parking is allowed on the street.

UNMETERED - The City of Oshkosh provides free, unmetered parking to all on-street users for two hours or less, unless otherwise signed.

METERED - Use meters as directed.

OFF-STREET PARKING

There are 18 public parking lots in Downtown Oshkosh. Over 1,560 parking stalls are available in various time increments (30-minute, 90-minute, 2-hour, 4-hour, 10-hour, 12-hour, and 24-hour).

METERED PARKING

METERS - Use meters as directed.

METERS WITH A BLUE BAND - Meters with this band, (as shown here) are 10+ hour meters and can take coins or can be used with a monthly permit.
