CONTRACT 22-10 WILLIAM WATERS GAZEBO CONSTRUCTION
OSHKOSH, WISCONSIN

The City of Oshkosh will receive and accept bids ONLY through QuestCDN.com via the online electronic bid service (www.QuestCDN.com) for the construction of the Williams Waters Gazebo until 1:00 p.m. on Monday, January 17, 2022. Bids will be opened and publicly read through a WebEx virtual meeting.

PROJECT is for the construction of a 290-sf outdoor cast-stone gazebo with associated site work. Project includes prefabricated cast stone veneer gazebo (coping, columns, architrave, gable veneer), back-up gable CMU wall, wood-framed roof structure, metal tile roofing, cement board soffit, metal railings, electrical, prefabricated cupola, and other associated work. The facility will be constructed with a concrete slab and concrete foundations.

It is the bidder's sole responsibility to insure the Bid is received by QuestCDN.com prior to the deadline set forth in this advertisement. No bids will be accepted after the deadline.

All bids must follow the bidding instructions, including providing all attachments as required, on QuestCDN.com.

Sealed Bids must be accompanied by an electronic Bid Bond payable to the City of Oshkosh in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the Bid as a guarantee that if the Bid is accepted, Bidder will execute and file proper Contract and Bond within ten (10) days after the award of the Contract. The Bid Bond can be presented in pdf format or via *Surety 2000*. If the successful bidder executes the Contract and files the necessary bonds within the allowed time, then the Bid Bond shall be released. If the successful bidder fails to execute the Contract and file the Contract Bond within the allowed time, then the Bid Bond shall be forfeited to the CITY as liquidated damages.

No bid may be withdrawn within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
