

The City of Oshkosh and GO-EDC Emergency Response Loan Program

The Greater Oshkosh Economic Development Corporation (GO-EDC) with a partnership with the City of Oshkosh has launched a program with seed funds of \$300,000 meant to ensure that Oshkosh area businesses have the funding they need for this emergency. GO-EDC is actively working with other organizations to increase the seed amount. Loans will be offered in the amounts of \$1,000, \$2,500, \$5,000, or \$10,000 with a 3-year amortization, 2% interest, and deferment of principal and interest for six months. Funds can be used for basic business needs including rent/mortgage payments, utility payments, payroll expenses, and pre-existing purchase orders.
