Oshkosh State of the City set for Monday, March 9

OSHKOSH, Wis. March 6, 2020 – The annual Oshkosh State of the City Address and City Exhibit Expo will be held at the Oshkosh Convention Center, 1 North Main Street, on Monday, March 9. The event, which will also include the presentation of Community Partnership Awards and Citizen Service Awards, will begin at 6 p.m.

At 6:30 p.m., the Citizen Service Awards and Community Partnership Awards will be presented by the Oshkosh Common Council. The Citizen Service Awards honor individuals who have achieved various five-year milestones serving on city boards and commissions, and the Community Partnership Awards recognize organizations that have played a role in enriching the city of Oshkosh through initiatives, programs, and support.

Immediately following the awards, City Manager Mark Rohloff will deliver the State of the City Address.
