**OSHKOSH, Wis., October 5, 2020** – The city of Oshkosh Parks Department has put together a safe way to trick-or-treat in 2020. The park will be lined with community sponsored treat stations. There is no need to get out of the car, as the volunteers will bring the candy to you! Attendees are asked to pay attention to what booth they think is the most creative so they can cast their vote and drop it in at the end of the event. Vehicles will enter the park from the entrance across from Webster Stanley Middle School. Should you dress up? Of course it is suggested to come in costume. The family car may also be given a Halloween makeover!

Tickets are limited, so attendees are asked to make their purchase early. Two time slots are being offered, 11:00 a.m. to Noon, or Noon to 1:00 p.m. Ticket cost is \$10.00 per family. When purchasing, you must create a “household”, if you don’t already have one, to purchase tickets online. If you do have a household set up you may purchase tickets with a mobile device.
