City of Oshkosh tax bills are being mailed today

OSHKOSH, Wis., December 14, 2020 – The City of Oshkosh would like to notify citizens that real estate and personal property tax bills are being mailed out today, December 14th, 2020.

Due to the COVID-19 public health pandemic, the city encourages residents to mail in their tax payments or use the drop box outside the main doors of City Hall. Residents are also encouraged to use the online payment option at www.OshkoshBillPay.com. Payments can be made in person at City Hall if necessary. City Hall's business hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. City Hall is closed on December 24 & 25, and January 1, 2021.

In addition, the City is designating Community First Credit Union (1492 South Park Ave., 2424 Westowne Ave., and 2772 Oregon St.) as an authorized payment location for in person payments. Tax payments must be made during regular business hours in the credit union lobby.

Individuals are asked to help avoid congestion in City Hall by considering other payment methods before deciding to pay taxes in person this year. Please help us to maintain a safe environment for everyone's good health.

In order to be credited with a 2020 tax payment, the payment must be received, paid in person at any location, or placed in the drop box located by the main entrance to City Hall by December 31, 2020.
