Christmas tree curbside collection begins January 4th

OSHKOSH, Wis., December 28, 2020 – The city of Oshkosh Sanitation Division would like to inform residents that residential curbside Christmas tree collection will take place on the regularly scheduled garbage collection day the weeks of January 4 through January 8 and January 18 through January 22, 2021.

- Trees must be removed from plastic bags.
- Place trees on the terrace or driveway apron, no later than 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled garbage collection day.
- Artificial or flocked trees will NOT be collected.
- Remove all decorations, lights and the tree stand. Trees must not be buried by snow.
- Christmas wreaths, garland or swags that contain a metal frame and artificial trees should be placed in the garbage cart.
- Trees may also be dropped off at the city's Yard Waste Drop-off Site. A permit is required to use the city's Yard Waste Drop-off Site. Winter hours are in effect from December 1st to March 31st. Winter hours for the Drop-off Site are 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, closed on weekends and holidays.
