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**City of Oshkosh is accepting grant proposals**

*Federal funds are available to support a variety of public service activities*

**OSHKOSH, Wis., March 18, 2021** – The City of Oshkosh will utilize federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to support a variety of public service activities. Grant proposals are being accepted from local non-profit organizations for the 2021 program year. The program year runs from May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022.

All clients benefitting from the use of CDBG funds must live within the city limits of Oshkosh. The proposal must provide a direct benefit for low to moderate income residents of Oshkosh. The funds can be used for administration, supplies, materials and other costs related to the implementation and operation of a program. No applications will be accepted for startup costs or capital expenditures such as vehicles, facility renovations, and similar items.
