Bowen Street closure scheduled for Wednesday, August 25th
Water service leak requires an emergency repair

OSHKOSH, Wis., August 23, 2021 – All lanes of Bowen Street between E. Lincoln Avenue and E. Irving Avenue will be closed to traffic on Wednesday, August 25th, 2021, beginning at 8:30 a.m. until approximately 4:30 p.m. If weather doesn't allow for the repair to be completed on Wednesday, it may occur on Thursday, August 26th. Travel will be closed from both directions, and signage is being put into place to advise motorists of the closure in advance. Access to properties within the closure will be maintained as much as possible. The closure is due to an emergency water line repair that needs to be made.

The detour routes motorists may take are:

Northbound: E. Irving Avenue west to N. Main Street, north on N. Main Street to Harrison Street, northeast on Harrison Street to E. Nevada Avenue, east on E. Nevada Avenue back to Bowen Street.

Southbound: E. Nevada Avenue west to Harrison Street, southwest on Harrison Street to N. Main Street, south on N. Main Street to E. Irving Avenue, east on E. Irving Avenue back to Bowen Street.

Motorists are urged to plan alternate routes and expect delays due to the closure. As always, please be cautious when approaching any construction zone.
