Algoma Boulevard closure scheduled to begin April 13th

OSHKOSH, Wis., April 7, 2022 – Algoma Boulevard between Wisconsin Street and West New York Avenue will be closed (to thru traffic) beginning on Wednesday, April 13th, for sanitary sewer, water main, and storm sewer construction. High Avenue from Osceola Street and West New York Avenue will temporarily have two-way traffic for access during the closure. This phase of construction is anticipated to last until October 28th.

These closures are required to complete the work within the road right-of-way in a safe manner for both the City's contractor's employees and the traveling public.

Signs have been posted on the Project route to notify motorists of the upcoming roadway closure.

Local traffic may take:

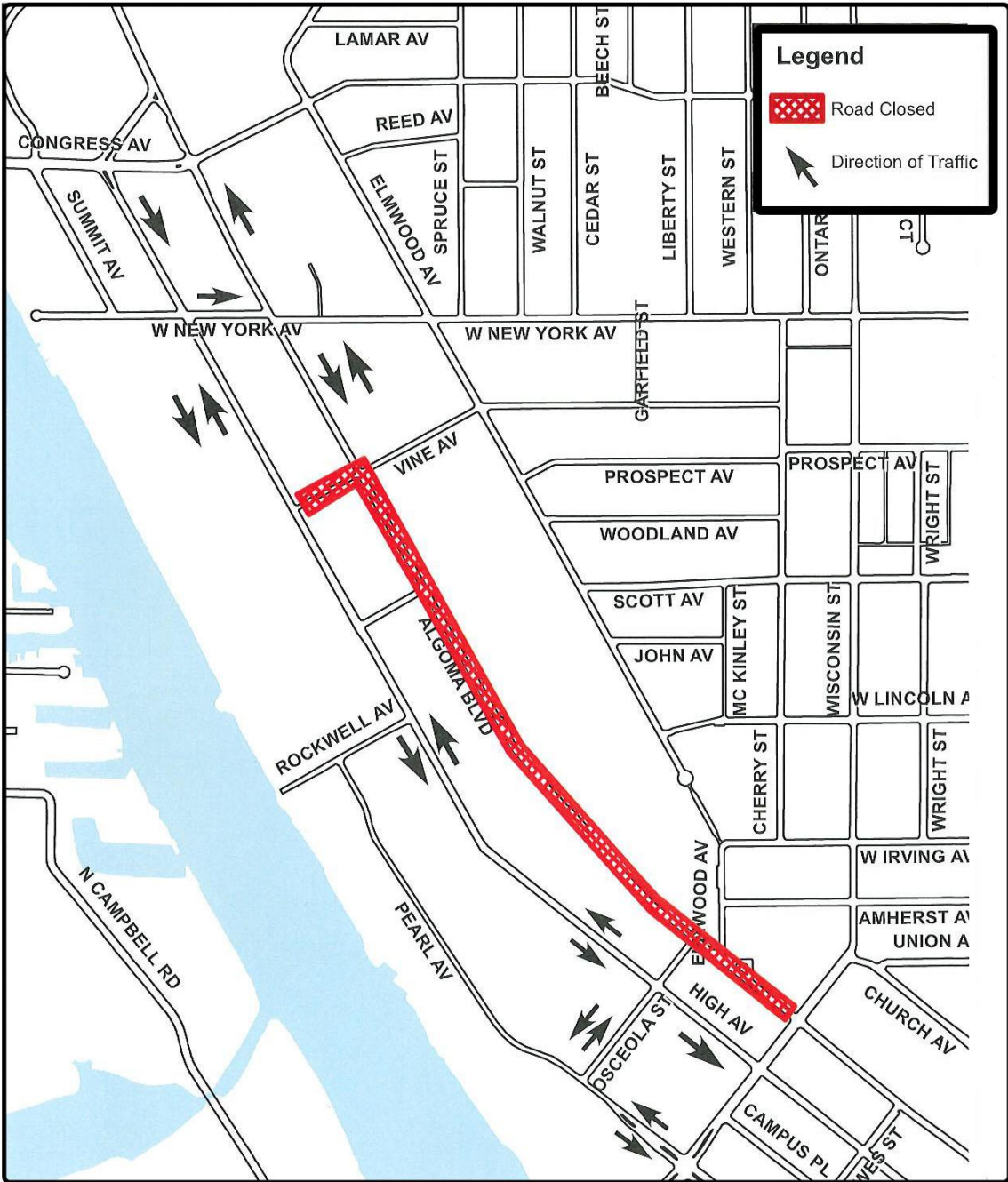
High Avenue Southbound/Northbound: Traveling south/north on High Avenue, temporary two-way traffic will be established from West New York Avenue to Osceola Street. Motorists shall have access to Vine Avenue, Woodland Avenue, and Rockwell Avenue.

Motorists are urged to plan alternate routes and expect delays due to the closure. As always, please be cautious when approaching any construction zone.
