A shade or ornamental tree, one and a half inches (1 1/2") in diameter transplanted ball and burlap.

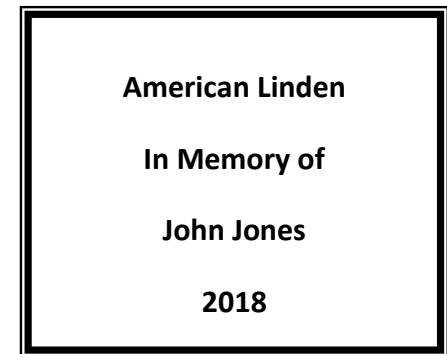
Ornamental Species:

American Hornbeam, Callery Pear, Flowering Crabs, Hawthorn, Ironwood, Japanese Tree Lilac, Serviceberry

Shade Tree Species:

Bur Oak, Catalpa, English Oak, Hackberry, Honey Locust, Kentucky Coffee Tree, Linden, Norway Maple, Pine, River Birch, Spruce, Sugar Maple, Swamp White Oak, Freeman Maple

Included with your selection is a 9"x12"x2" marker, which will be placed in the ground near the tree. The inscription on the marker can be up to 3 lines in addition to the tree species name, with a maximum of 15 letters and spaces per line (sample below).
